

### CHURCH COUNCIL UPDATE

We continue working with the Northern Illinois Synod, regarding the placement of an interim pastor. As you may be aware, the roster of eligible Interim pastors is in short supply. In the meantime, we will work with Pulpit Supply pastors, until an interim becomes available.


